This important level of accreditation is the pinnacle of achievement for strategic risk and resilience professionals. It is recognition of the highest standards in knowledge, proficiency and thought leadership.

Those granted certification will be able to use the post-nominals 'CSRP' (Certified Strategic Risk Professional) and must comply with a code of conduct and complete an annual record of continuous professional development.

COMPETENCY FRAMEWORK

The following makes up the Competency Framework, which will be used to assess applicants, together with the submission of a full CV, copies of any publications authored by the applicant and attending an assessment interview.

During the assessment interview you will be required to demonstrate a detailed knowledge of strategic risk methodologies and best practice, including examples of thought leadership and the development of innovative frameworks and solutions.

ENTRY LEVEL REQUIREMENTS

Persons submitting themselves for certification must meet a minimum entry requirement.

This includes (Mandatory):



Qualified to a minimum of a relevant bachelor's degree or equivalent professional certification such as the ISRM Level 6 Diploma in Strategic Risk and Crisis Management



Proven in thought leadership



Proven skills in strategic risk problem-solving.

KNOWLEDGE & SKILLS



KNOWLEDGE

- Demonstrate a proven track record of formal qualifications and continuous professional development
- Be able to evidence thought leadership and influence within the sector of strategic risk and resilience management
- Knowledge of a range of strategic risk management issues, methodologies and processes
- Possess a detailed understanding of 'Wicked Problems' and potential options for engagement



SKILLS

- Strong communication skills, including public speaking
- The ability to conduct research, create innovative solutions and influence change
- Good interpersonal skills with senior managers, junior staff (mentoring) and the public
- Present and discuss proposals for strategic risk and resilience projects
- Demonstrate innovation within the sector



PERSONAL COMMITMENT

- Demonstrate a commitment to Continuous Professional Development
- Submit one research paper per annum for publication by the ISRM and inclusion in the ISRM library
- Play an active role in the ISRM strategic risk management community



LEADERSHIP

- Proven leadership skills at the senior management level or above in strategic risk
- Proven leadership in the development and implementation of strategic risk management projects



EXPERIENCE

- A minimum of 10 years' experience within the strategic risk management landscape
- A proven track record of leadership and influence in strategic risk management roles

APPLICATION PROCESS

1

APPLY

The ISRM is now welcoming applications. Please complete the formal application form together with payment of the initial application fee.

2

SUBMIT EVIDENCE

The application must include a personal letter of introduction and the submission of the completed application form including two original pieces of work and copies of any publications you have authored (website links are acceptable but the details of the accredited author should be clear).

3

INITIAL ASSESSMENT

Once an application and accompanying portfolio is received, an initial assessment will be completed before successful candidates are invited to attend an assessment interview with members of the CSRP Validation Board..

4

ASSESSMENT INTERVIEW

Having passed the interview stage, successful candidates will be notified and final payment will be required.

5

FINAL PAYMENT & REGISTER

Successful candidates will be entered on to the Register of Strategic Risk Professionals and qualify to use the post nominals CSRP.

The full cost to become a Certified Strategic Risk Professional is £425.00 (+VAT). This is reduced to £375.00 for ISRM members. An initial non-refundable payment of £75.00 will be required upon initial application which will be deducted from the final cost to successful applicants.

An annual fee will also apply to remain on the register of Certified Strategic Risk Management Professionals. This has been set at £125.00 for non-members and £75 for Fellows of the ISRM.
